Exchange trips enable future faculty to present research at CIRTL institutions

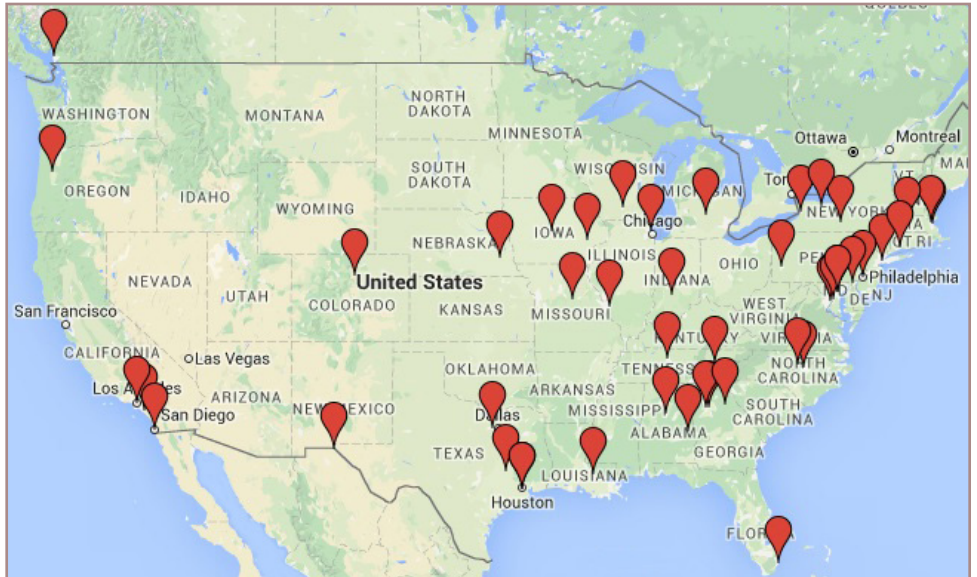
CIRTL'S NETWORK EXCHANGE PROGRAM

is a two- to three-day visit to a host campus within the CIRTL Network. The program is designed to allow advanced graduate students and post-docs to practice professional skills before entering the job market, while also networking with education and disciplinary colleagues at the host institution.

PARTICIPANTS present a disciplinary research talk and a Teaching-as-Research project, and interact with colleagues and potential collaborators at the host institution. Ask your local CIRTL program leaders about ways to get involved in research on teaching.

HOST INSTITUTIONS also benefit by welcoming an early-career scholar from another institution, enhancing their pool of qualified applicants for future academic positions.
