

CIRTL Graduate Assistant Position - TAR Focus (Summer 2020 – Summer 2021)

The IUPUI Center for Teaching and Learning (CTL) and the IUPUI Graduate Office invite applications for a Graduate Assistant (GA) who will develop and deliver programming for CIRTL. CIRTL, the [Center for the Integration of Research, Teaching, and Learning](#), is a network of 37 universities dedicated to the advancement of undergraduate education in STEM and other disciplines through the development of future faculty. As a [part of its membership for CIRTL](#), IUPUI has developed local programming for the CIRTL Network, including a [CIRTL at IUPUI Canvas course](#). Interested candidates should review the CIRTL [core ideas](#), [values](#), and [program outcomes](#) prior to applying.

The GA will be expected to work approximately 20 hours per week with a flexible schedule of working on or off-campus. The GA will work closely with the CIRTL leadership in the Graduate Office and the CTL to assist in the planning, development, and facilitation of local CIRTL programming in the following ways:

- develop and offer the Teaching-as-Research program for CIRTL at IUPUI.
- develop content for other types of graduate student and postdoc programming, which includes workshops, webinars, learning community meetings, etc.
- provide organizational support:
 - Design print and web promotional materials for CIRTL and CTL TA development events/programming
 - Update and manage the CIRTL at IUPUI website and Canvas course
 - Manage email correspondences with program participants and other program logistics
- co-present in CIRTL-related workshops and webinars
- conduct literature review to locate and evaluate scholarly resources on teaching and learning
- document the program development and evaluation data
- perform other related tasks as assigned

Required Qualifications:

- At least one semester of experience as a graduate teaching assistant at IUPUI or other institutions
- Excellent organizational, communication, and research skills
- Genuine interest in faculty and future-faculty professional development in higher education
- Enrolled in a graduate program at IUPUI

Preferred Qualifications:

- Completion of a pedagogy course
- Currently pursuing or interested in STEM education research
- Experience with scholarship of teaching and learning
- Expected graduation date is on or after Spring 2021

Graduate students in STEM-focused disciplines, Liberal Arts, Social Sciences, and especially Education are encouraged to apply. This position will report to the CTL. Compensation will include health insurance and tuition remission.
